Erasmus+ mobility is one of the most successful programs of the European Union, with a significant impact on students' lives. Students go through a life-changing experiences by studying or completing a European or other associated countries' traineeship. Erasmus+ experience introduces Erasmus+ participants to new and different worlds and perspectives, new ideas, and new cultures. It motivates them and fills them with an eagerness to contribute to their community. However, the COVID-19 outbreak has negatively affected ongoing or planned activities under the Erasmus+ program in 2020, and most of the Erasmus+ program mobility will most probably continue online in 2021. This shift opens up a lot of questions related to what will happen to the Erasmus+ mobility? How do students respond to these changes? How do they see the future?

The COVID-19 pandemic enters a new phase this autumn. In these disruptive times, the Centre "Science and Innovation for Development" ([SciDEV](#)), and Erasmus Student Network Albania ([ESN Tirana](#)) motivated by the National Erasmus+ Office in Albania are organizing a roundtable whereby students discuss the future of Erasmus+ mobility.
